



Replayer Version 1.7.0

Replayer is a free, cue-based media player for rehearsals with playback music. By the click of a button, Replayer starts to play at predefined times in the audio file.

Getting started

First, you create a compilation of tracks and cues once, using a wizard from within Replayer.

Rehearse

Then, using Replayer and your laptop computer, you can rehearse any portion of your set with ease.

This block provides a detailed view of the keyboard's navigation and rehearsal functions. Callouts point to specific keys and their functions.

- Back 1 cue / Rewind
- Forward 1 cue / Fast forward
- Volume down
- Volume up
- Pause / Continue
- Return to cue
- Numbers: Type a shortcut, terminate with ENTER
